
Dear Ms. Abe:

We are pleased to inform you that the U.S. Board on Geographic Names, at its February 8, 2018 meeting, approved your proposal to make official the name Marys Brook for a stream in Middlesex County.

The name has been added to the Geographic Names Information System, the nation's official geographic names repository, which is available and searchable online at <https://geonames.usgs.gov>. The entry reads as follows:

Marys Brook: stream; approx. 0.9 mi. long; in the Town of Acton, heads at 42°28'57"N, 71°26'06"W, flows generally S to enter Coles Brook 0.9 mi. E of Kelly Corner; the name commemorates Mary S. Michelman (1960-2010), environmental activist and founder of the Acton Stream Teams; Middlesex County, Massachusetts; 42°28'21"N, 71°26'11"W; USGS map – Maynard 1:24,000; Not: Mary's Brook.
